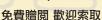
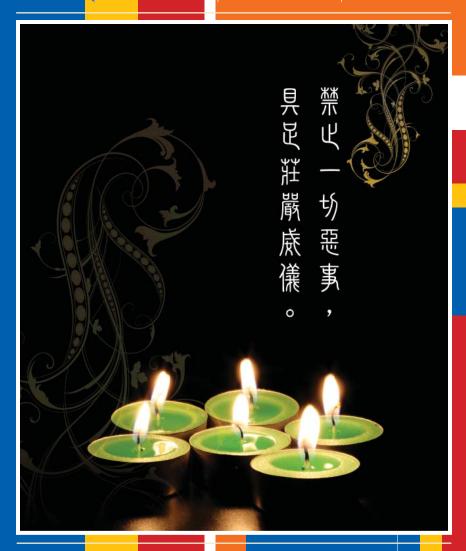

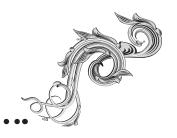

那麼我就將我所修學的經驗告訴 你吧!我所修學的是念佛法門。 一個念佛的行者,首先必須具備 有堅定的信心,以及對真理的了 解,才能不受任何境界所動,當 念佛念到一心不亂的時候,就是 一種三昧的境界,在這個時候我 的眼根清淨,可以看見十方諸佛 的種種色相、形貌、神通、遊戲 以及一切眾會道場的莊嚴。諸佛 菩薩的佛土,隨著眾生不同的心 樂,而示現種種成正覺門,更由 於對於真理的明瞭,斷除了內心 一切煩惱執著的障礙,便可以在 一念之間稱著自己的心念,去到 十方諸佛的國土,恭敬供養一切 諸佛,這一切都是因為我修學念 佛法門,所證得的自在解脱力。 一位初發心的行者,必須要能念 佛的名字念到心口不離佛。身常 恭敬佛,以佛的名號,佛的功德 來堅定自己的信心,因為信是進 入佛法大海的一把鑰匙, 所以我 堅持修學這一個法門,才達到十 信滿心的果位,安住於佛法,不 產牛懈怠退道的障礙。

善男子,我所證得的解脱門叫【 憶念一切諸佛境界智慧光明普見 法門】。事實上,諸佛菩薩無邊 智慧的清淨行門並不止如此,據 我所知,念佛三昧的法門就有二 上一種,而我所知道的只是其中 之一而已。至於其它的二十一種,我也只能舉例給你聽,就是所謂:

智光普照念佛門; 令一切眾生念佛門; 今安住力念佛門; 今安住法念佛門; 照耀諸方念佛門; 入不可見處念佛門; 住於諸劫念佛門; 住一切時念佛門; 住一切剎念佛門; 住一切世念佛門; 住一切境念佛門; 住寂滅念佛門; 住遠離念佛門; 住廣大念佛門; 住微細念佛門; 住莊嚴念佛門; 住能事念佛門; 住自在心念佛門; 住白業念佛門; 住神變念佛門; 住虚空念佛門; 善男子,如果你想作更深入的 解,那麼就必須再去請教其他的 善知識了! 經

大方廣佛華嚴經卷第五十三・離世间品第三十八之一・第8间何等 為 戒

華 嚴 經 問 答 與 內 容

〈離世間品〉是《華嚴經》中的二千個修行法門,由普慧菩薩為當 機眾代眾生向普賢菩薩發問,總共發出了二百個問題,而普賢菩薩 於每個問題中説出了十個答案,即十個修行法門,故孕品經一共有 二千個法門,成為了「普慧二百問,普賢兩千酬」的佳話,給後人 研讀華嚴經的一個重要指南。

第八問~何等為戒

經文(P154L2):佛子!菩薩摩訶薩有十種戒。何等為十?所謂:

- 1 · 不捨菩提心戒;
- 2. 遠離二乘地戒;
- 3 · 觀察利益一切眾生戒;
- 4 · 令一切眾生住佛法戒;
- 5 · 修一切菩薩所學戒;
- 6 · 於一切法無所得戒;
- 7. 以一切善根迴向菩提戒;
- 8 · 不著一切如來身戒;
- 9. 思惟一切法離取著戒;
- 10·諸根律儀戒。

是為十。若諸菩薩安住此法,則得如來無上廣大戒波羅蜜。

釋文(V17P59L4):

「戒」者,大乘菩薩要成就「眾生」,必須自身根本止息惡行,彰顯善業以圓滿成就眾生的大願。其實,單看這三句中,已清楚闡明了三聚淨戒。在〈華嚴經‧離世間品〉中中,身口意三業都有提到,包括戒律。戒律屬身業,身業如何修學?經文顯示,菩薩有十種戒,其實這十種戒中不離三聚淨戒:攝善法戒、攝律儀戒及饒益眾生戒,如下表:

以上經文所提的十種戒,是不離菩提心。若忘失菩提心,必招六根 犯戒境,故犯戒重業,可說是破了菩薩戒境。從不捨菩提心起,由 於發起了菩提心,對於聽聞一切法都加以思惟,遠離取著的心,進 一步把一切所做的善業以迴小向大的心念迴向給有情,成就了遠離 取著戒及迴向菩提戒。

攝律儀戒是以「嚴防」為體,嚴格防範錯誤的心念與行動,禁止一切惡事,具足莊嚴威儀。「律」是戒律,是約束、禁止的意思;「儀」是儀態,是日常生活中的舉止與形態。攝律儀就是攝持大乘佛法的精神,積極推行該做的事,嚴格禁止不該做的事。所以菩薩該以遠離二乘地為主,乃至最後可以成就諸根律儀戒。

上文屬於饒益眾生戒有四句,以不離利益眾生的心念,令眾生安住於佛法中,上文所説以菩提心修菩薩行及修菩薩所修,但令眾生不 著於一切法,形成於一切法無所得戒,此為饒益眾生的核心。 ^經

華 嚴 三 祖 賢 首 國 師

三祖賢首國師(西元643 年-712年)名法藏,俗姓康, 母於夢中吞下日光而懷孕。從小 智慧非凡,十十歲為求佛法、入 太白山,過出世的生活,以持誦 華嚴經為平常功課。當時智儼 和尚在雲華寺講華嚴經,因此 禮和尚為師,深入研究華嚴於雲 華寺。智儼和尚圓寂時曾留下遣 言: "法藏用意華嚴,可紹隆大 法,應使出家。"當時,適逢武 則天廣植福田,度僧,將住它捨 施為太原寺,當時著名諸大德道 成、薄塵推薦。隨即奉敕削髮於 太原寺, 並為主持。上元元年, 武后命京城十大德,為師授戒, 賜號賢首。復詔師於太原寺講華 嚴,聽者絡緩不絕。

法藏大師善巧教化,唯武后對華 嚴經中義理,茫然未明,師因此 取長生殿前之金獅子,説明無盡 緣起的道理,武後豁然開解。 後又取銅鏡置十面八方,上下各一,相距一丈多,面面相對,中間安置一尊佛像,燃一火蠋照亮之,由是交光互影,顯現重重無盡之妙理。

國師雖身為五帝門師,依然穿著簡樸;其一以禪悅為食,其二以持戒忍辱自守,弘法利生為務。玄宗先天元年,預知時至,十一月十四日,於西京大薦福寺吉祥而逝。世壽七十,臘四十三,敕諡「賢首大師」。

賢首國師著作甚多,主要有《華嚴經探玄記》、《華嚴一乘教義分齊章》、《華嚴經旨歸》、《華嚴經黃海百門》、《修華嚴奧旨妄盡還源觀》、《華嚴經金獅子章》、《華嚴經傳記》、《大乘起信論義記》等。經

美國華嚴蓮社於1/14及1/15特別舉辦兩場佛學講座,禮請馬來西籍開照比丘宣講如何修持慈心禪。開照比丘出生於馬來西亞,24歲在檳城洪福寺出家於馬來西亞佛學院。1988年開始監獄弘法,二十多年的監獄弘法中,他的慈悲不知軟化了多少身陷囹圄,手腳帶著重重鐐銬的硬漢子,進而皈依佛教。

來點出佛教以善業為本和通於 三世的福報觀。同時指出一般世 間以長壽,財富,健康,成就美 德,乃至臨終吉祥的普通世俗觀 念不僅不能圓滿也難得究竟。

法師又開示佛教的福報觀包括 了世間與出世間的快樂的深意。 佛教的修習善業離不開智慧的 引導,重點在於每人每一念的善 心。

在短短一小時內,法師妙語如珠,精簡扼要地為大眾開示完畢後,隨即前往杉磯展開下一次的弘法活動。 ^經

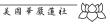

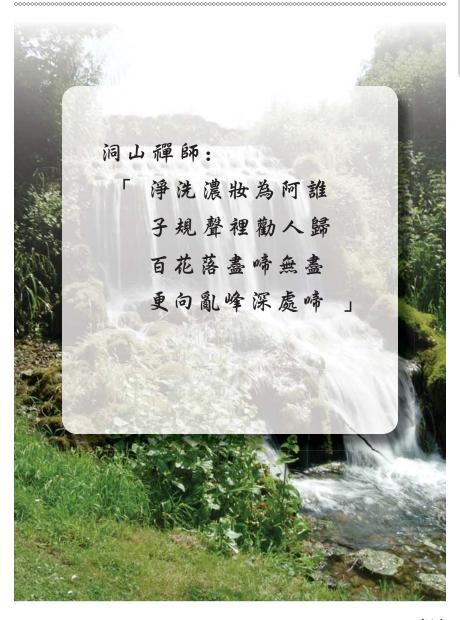

佛旗

五色旗總共六條,前五條是單色,一條一個顏色,代表佈施、 持戒、忍辱、精進、禪定;後一 條是雜色,五種顏色都有,代表 般若。

第一條紋藍色,象徵佛陀頂

上紺碧之螺髻,盤結堅定,示「 禪定」。同時有代表慈悲與平和 的含義。

第二條紋黃色,象徵佛陀紫 金光聚之妙色身,圓滿堅固不 壞,如「金剛」。同時有代表中 道,離於空、有的意義。

第三條紋赤色,象徵佛陀對眾生的哀憫,如熱血流注,常行教化,法雨普施,永無止息的大「精進」。同時有代表成就福慧,莊嚴吉祥的含義。

第四條紋白色,象徵佛陀作獅子吼,金口御齒之色,清凈潔白,能噬斷一切惡業諸煩惱,示「清凈」。同時有代表清凈解脱,法爾如是的含義。

第五條紋橙黃色,象徵佛陀 聖體所披袈裟的顏色。袈裟者又

名「忍辱鎧」,能拒欲誘,能御 時有代表佛法的本質,是從智慧 莊嚴而成的含義。

關於佛教旗幟的顏色製定,一種 説法是根據佛陀成道時, 聖體放 種説法指此五色為佛陀渡化天、 人、畜生、餓鬼和地獄五道時所 放射的光芒。

佛旗是一位美國新聞記者亨利: 惱害,示學佛陀之「忍辱」。同 斯太爾·奧爾科特在1880年設 計的。1885年佛教旗在斯里蘭 卡作為信仰與和平的象徵第一次 正式使用。1951年世界佛教友 前會在斯里蘭卡成立,將五色旗 定為會旗,之後逐漸為全世界佛 出六種色光,來製成佛旗。另一 教信眾所認可,五色旗遂成為佛 教世界共同標誌。

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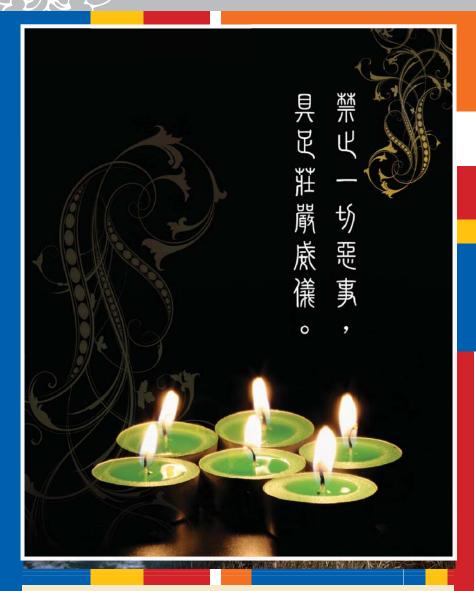

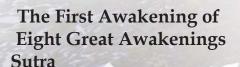

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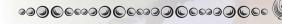

Buddhism to Know_

THE BUDDHIST FLAG

The Buddhist flag is a modern creation; jointly designed by Mr. J.R. de Silva and Colonel Henry S. Olcott to mark the revival of Buddhism in Ceylon in 1880. It was accepted as the International Buddhist Flag by the 1952 World Buddhist Congress.

Colonel Olcott designed the flag using six colors which he believed formed the aura around the head of the Buddha after His Enlightenment.

The flag was invented to symbolize the special features of Buddhism. Its six colors were taken from the rays which radiated from the Holy Body of the Buddha immediately after he attained enlightenment under the Bodhi Tree at Buddhagaya in India.

The six colors are:

- Blue: signifying the concept of loving kindness and peacefulness in Buddhism.
- Yellow: signifying the Middle Path, that is, the complete absence of form and emptiness. A mind free from greed, anger and ignorance.
- Red: signifying achievement, wisdom, virtue, fortune and dignity.

- White: signifying purity, emancipation, and timelessness, meaning the Dharma will always exist and continue to, regardless of time or space.
- Orange: The essence of Buddhism which is full of wisdom, strength and dignity.
- The combination of these five colors symbolizes that it is the one and only Truth.

The horizontal bars signify peace and harmony between all races throughout the world while the vertical bars represent eternal peace within the world.

In simple terms, the Buddhist Flag implies that there is no discrimination of races, nationality, areas or skin color; that every living being possess the Buddha Nature and have the potential to become a Buddha.

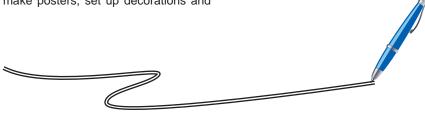

If I know a little bit more logic and reasoning than others, it is because I have

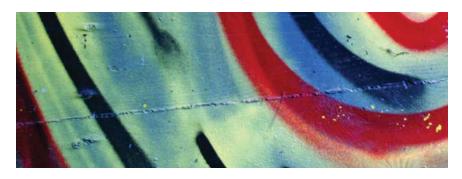
made more mistakes than other have.
